TRUST DEED

- (vi) Sri Bishwesh Arya, son of Sri Dayanath Sah by faith Hindu, by Occupation Service, resident of 3 B, Sridhar Apartment, Bardwan Compound, P.S. Lalpur, P.O. Ranchi (CRO), District Ranchi, in the state of Jharkhand.

Herinafter collectively called as the TRUCTEES (which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include their survivor or survivors the trustees for the time being of these presents and their successors or successors in office and assigns) of the OTHER PART.

WHEREAS

1.

- (a) The Settler is desirous of setting a sum of Rs 11,000/- (Rupees Eleven Thousand only) for the charitable purpose and objects in the Union of India and / or abroad as hereinafter mentioned. In pursuance of the aforesaid desire and for carrying out such desire into effect, the Settlers have settled Rs 11,000 (Rupees Eleven Thousand Only) on the Trustees.
- (b) The Trustees have agreed to act as Trustees of these presents upon the terms and conditions hereinafter contained.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH as follows:

That in order to effectuate his said desire and for diverse other good causes and consideration hereto moving the Settler do hereby transfer assigns and make over to the trustees the sum of Rs 11,000 (Rupees Eleven Thousands Only) and all rights, title, interest, claim and demand whatsoever of the said Settler in to and

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upon the said sum of Rs. 11,000 (Rupees Eleven Thousands Only) and every party thereof TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said and the investment for the time being representing the same and all other sums, shares, securities and other properties which may be received by the Trustees hereinafter by way of donation, gift, subscription, income, interest, dividend or otherwise whatsoever or howsoever accruing that may for the time being form the assets of the said Trust (hereinafter for the sake brevity referred to as the Trust property) upon trust for public and charitable purpose and uses and with subject to the powers, provisions and declarations herein contained or concerning the same.

- 2 The name of the Trust shall be SANT PATHIK SEWAK SAMAJ TRUST herein called the TRUST
- 3 The office of the trust shall be situated at village: Ratanganj, P.S. Sajor, P.O. Ratanganj Dist: Bhagalpur, in the State of Bihar and / or such other place or places in India as the Trustees may decide from time to time.
- The Trustees shall get in and collect the income, interest, dividend and profit of the Trust property from time to time and shall there from pay at first instance all costs, charges and expenses of and incidental to the administration and management of the Trust property and shall hold the net balance of the income and the corpus of the Trust property for the objects hereinafter mentioned.
- The objects for which the Trust is established are relief of the poor, education, women empowerment, medical relief, self dependence irrespective of caste, creed, receive religion or language and the advancement of any other objects of general public unity, not involving any activity for profit and for such purposes: -
 - To establish a university and/or educational institution related to Information technology field, Research institutes, Polytechnics, Schools, Vocational and Management training institutions, Teacher Training Institute, Medical, Center of instruction and diffusion of useful knowledge, Issue of any degree, diploma or Certificates etc. only after the due approval of the competent authority, wherever applicable..
 - Dependence, irrespective of caste, creed, race, religion or language and advancement of any other object of general public utility.
 - To establish, acquire, take over open, found, build, maintain, promote, set up, assist, support, aid, run, help, encourage and manage schools, colleges, institutions and other places of education for the promotion of knowledge and imparting education of all descriptions including primary, secondary and higher education in all subjects and disciplines.
 - To establish places of education for the promotion of knowledge among the people without making any distinction of caste, creed, race or religion and in the interest of mankind in general. The people of any community can come and become a part of the educational activities conducted in that place.

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- (v) To establish, maintain and support studentship and scholarship for poor, needy and deserving students and scholar of the schools, colleges, universities and other educational and technical institution.
- (vi) To Award scholarships, give loans to needy students on easy terms regarding repayment with or without interest or remitting the said loans in full or in a part and to Pay for needy students' school fees, college fees, books, instruments, tools etc.
- (vii) To pay whole or part of educational costs of deserving students.
- (viii) To give Subscriptions, contribution and /or donations to any schools, colleges, public funds, orphanages or other public institutions for advancement and propagation of education and knowledge for promotion of any public charitable objects.
- (ix) To establish or give and/or grant aid to Schools, Colleges, Hostels, Libraries and other Educational Institution and establishment for the development of education and diffusion of Knowledge and public rest house and to provide amenities for the public there at.
- (x) To foster and encourage education and training in handicrafts, fine arts, among women folk in general and establish and found institutions imparting such education and to establish maintain, support or help by monetary gifts of otherwise, centers and institutions for women and children and to provide social Welfare works for women and children.
- (xi) To open, found, establish, promote, advance and encourage and/or aid in helping, promoting, advancing and encouraging primary, secondary and higher education including Institute/Institutes of management, technical and medical education physical training, training of handicrafts, fine art and other useful arts, crafts among the public.

To grant relief on the occasion of earthquake, land-slides, famine or flood or other calamities of similar nature and to give donations to institutions, fund establishments for relief on such occasions;

(xiii) To grant aid and/or donate money to any fund, object or institution, establishment engaged in advancement of any public charitable purposes as aforesaid;

(ViV)

- To establish, construct, erect. build, organize, manage, undertake, promote, develop, own, acquire, purchase, improve, equip, initiate, encourage, provide, maintain, operate, conduct, subsidies, take on lease, own and run in India or abroad diagnostic centers, scan centers, nursing home, hospitals, clinics, polyclinics, dispensaries, chemist shops, blood banks, eye banks, maternity homes, child welfare, family planning centers, clinical & pathological testing laboratories, consulting chambers, X-RAY & ECG clinics, sonography centers, physiotherapy centers, polio clinics, dialysis centers, Investigation centre, research laboratories & centers and/or institutions rendering medical help and assistance to the member of the public.
- (xv) To provide research facilities for carrying on research, basic and applied, in all system and disciplines of medical and surgical Knowledge, keeping in

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view the socio-medical and socio-economic needs of the afflicted community.

- (xvi) To encourage the discovery of new medica! and / or surgical management of disease and affections and to investigate and make known the nature merits of investigations and findings and research in the said field.
- (xvii) To provide, encourage, initiate or promote facilities for the discovery, improvement or development of new methods of diagnosis, understanding and prevention and treatment of diseases.
- (xviii) To conduct and to carry on experiments and to provide funds for research works and for scholarship, stipends, remuneration and/or other payments or aid to any person or persons engaged in research work, or work connected with or conducive to research and to encourage and to improve knowledge of the person who are engaged or likely to be engaged in any medical or related profession so as to make available medical relief to the public at large
- (xix) To grant aid or other financial assistance and otherwise provide for the aged and old people, illegitimate children, orphans, widows and for the other poor and /or socially distressed people.
- (xx) To help in the preservation of cattle and useful animals.
- (xxi) To undertake any programme of conservation of natural resources.
- To publish or cause to be published or assist in the publication of books, pamphlets, magazines and drawings in or about scientific, religious, cultural, philosophical scriptures and arts.
- (xxiii) To acquire, construct, build, maintain and manage Dharamsalas.
- (xxiv) To establish, building, maintain and mange Homes for Aged and old people, Homes for illegitimate children, orphans, widows and for the other poor and /or socially distressed people.
- (xxv) To give, provide and/or render help and assistance in case or kind to poor and/or destitute people, widows etc.
- (xxvi) To give, provide and/or render help and assistance to and/or implement any scheme-providing livelihood and up liftment of the poor.
- (xxvii) To give, provide and/or render food, medicine and other help and/or assistance in any shape or form to the poor deserving and needy person.
- (xxviii) To establish, maintain and manage a home, hostel for the boarding and lodging of the scholars, research students working women, trainees, or other person or persons irrespective of creed, casts or faith who may be engaged in the execution of or in furtherance of the aims and objects of the Trust.
- (xxix) To build, maintain and manage places of worship open for all people irrespective of caste, creed and faith and to do renovation or repair of any temple or other public places as is notified by the Central Government in the official Gazette to be of historic, archeological or artistic importance or a place of public worship or renown throughout any state or states.

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- (xxx) To build, maintain and manage auditorium, gymnasiums, health centers, playing fields exhibition halls, stadiums and community halls for the integrated and wholesome development of the general public.
- (xxxi) To establish, maintain and manage institutions for development of sports and grant aid or financial assistance to organizations already engaged in the sports activities establishments or person during such relief work.
- (xxxii) The income as also the corpus of the trust fund shall be applied and be applicable only to or for such public charitable purpose only an within such territories only and subject to such conditions or limitations if any, as may from time to time be laid down in the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any other Act governing tax of on income as well insure or make the trust hereby established and its income as eligible for exemption for taxation under the income Tax Act, 1961 or any reenactment thereof or modification thereof or under any other Act governing taxation for the time being in force in India.
- (xxxiii) The Trust hereby establishment shall be one to which the provisions of section 80G of the lncome Tax Act, 1961 or any replacement, reenactment or modification thereof for the time being in force may apply so that any donation made there to may be recognize as eligible for exemption or relief from tax in the hands of the donor.
- (xxxiv)To borrow, raise loans from any persons, bank or financial institutions in such manner as the trustees shall think proper or convenient for the furtherance of object of the Trust and for this propose the Trustees may secure repayment of these loans in any manner, as may be decided from time to time.
- (xxxv) To undertake any programme of rural development.
- (xxxvi) If any one or more of the objects specified in Clause (5) of these presents are held not to be objects of a public charitable nature the trustees shall not carry out such objects or objects as if the same are not incorporated in these present but the validity of the trust created by these presents as a trust for public charitable purpose shall not be affected in any manner.
- (xxxvii) To do all necessary thing for and incidental or conducive to the attainment of above objectives of the Trust.
- (xxxyiii) the Trustees shall be entitled and be at liberty to receive upon such terms as may think fit subscriptions donations, contributions and gifts in cash or in kind and/ or grants and/ or other funds, devices and bequest from the central and the state governments and from any person, institution, trust or corporate body and to collect funds by public or private appeals for carrying out the objects of the Trust.
- (xxxix) To establish dairy farm, honey farm, and any other farm which is useful for the public as mass for the purpose of obtaining/ distributing/ selling/ converting milk/ honey etc.
- 6. In pursuance and fulfillment of the objects of the trust the trustees may take all necessary steps and indulge in all such activities as are likely to promote the said objects directly or indirectly and to this and shall have all necessary powers including the following:



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- (a) To manage the Trust properties and to do all act necessary for the preservations, maintenance and management of the trust and/or the trust property.
- (b) The Trustees will be at liberty to invest the moneys, income and accretions thereof of the Trust property whether representing the corpus or the income thereof in such investment as the Trustees, in their absolute discretion, shall think fit and proper.
- (c) From time to time vary the investment representing the trust property and/or part thereof or the income from the property and liberty to sell or otherwise deal with any of the assets forming part of the trust.
- (d) To acquire by purchase, gift, lease, exchange, hire or otherwise with or without consideration, properties, movable or immovable for any or more of the objects of the Trust.
- (e) To manage, lease, mortgage, sell dispose of or otherwise deal with all or any part of the properties of the Trust provided always that the mortgage, lease or sale of any such assets or property of the Trust shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations and shall be for achieving the objects of the Trust.
- (f) To borrow with or without security or raise money in such manner and on such terms as may be necessary and good for achieving the objects of the trust subject to the previous approval of the Trustees and for this purpose the Trustees may secure repayments in any manner; as may be decided from time to time.
- (g) To purchase and otherwise acquire land by way of gift or otherwise and to build and maintain houses and homes and alter and improve the same and to provide all such houses and buildings with light, water, drainage and other necessaries.
- (h) The Trustees shall cause true and accurate accounts kept of all moneys received and spent and of all matters and things in respect thereof in course of management of trust property or relation to the carrying out the objects purposes of the trust as well as the assets, credits and effects of the Trust property.
- (i) To compromise, compound, abandon, submit to arbitration or otherwise settle any debt account, claim or dispute whatsoever relating to the trust property or any part thereof.
- (j) To delegate his or their powers or duties under the Trust to co-trustee or any other person if found necessary in the course of carrying out or performing of his or their duties.
- (k) To open and operate any accounts or accounts whether fixed or current or savings in the name of the Trust with any scheduled Bank or Banks and/or to close all of any such account or accounts or any of them as the Trustees may deem fit and proper. The Trustees may give desired instructions to the Bank regarding Opening, Operating and closing of accounts by one or more of the trustee. The trustees may authorise one of its manager to operate the said bank accounts along with one or more of the trustees.
- (I) The Trustees shall be entitled in their discretion from time to time to start, discontinue, abolish and re-start any aid charity or charitable institutions, to impose any condition or conditions to any subscription or donation made by them and to earmark any portion of the trust property or income for any particular object or objects.
- (m) To amalgamate the Trust and the Trust property with any other trust or institution having objects incidental or similar to these of this Trust, provided always that any such amalgamation shall be effected only in the event of absolute necessary and subject to the consent of majority of the Trustees for the time being and upon their certifying that such amalgamation was for the efficient functioning and in furtherance of the objects of this trust.



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- (n) To appoint/ authorize the Managing trustee to nominate, engage or appoint, constituted attorney or agent, manager, director, cashier, secretary, principal, accountant and other officials or employees to delegate any of the duties and powers to such constituted attorneys or agents with regard to the management of the Trust property and all matter relating to the trust for the purpose of carrying out the objects and purpose of the trust, operation and maintenance of bank account and for collection and realization of the income from trust properties and receipts of money, donations and gifts without being responsible for the default of any such attorney or agent.
- (p) To appoint/ authorize Managing Trustee to appoint clerk, Manager, Unit head, director, and other employees for the management of the Trust property and/or to look after the affairs thereof and to delegate to them such duties or powers as deemed necessary. The managing trustees shall also have the power and authority to remove, suspend or dismiss one or more of persons so appointed.
- (q) To do all such other deeds, acts and things as are or may be deemed incidental or conducive to the attainment of any or more of the objects of the Trust. However in case the trustees take or hold any property which may be subject to any bequests, the Trustees shall only deal with or invest the same in such manner as allowed by law or by any court of law having regard to such bequests.
- (r) To arrange for and/or authorize the signing or execution of any agreement, contract, instrument, document or any other paper or writing required to be signed or executed on behalf of the trustees by any one of the trustees to be nominated in this behalf by the Board of Trustees and to make the same effective and binding as if the said agreement in writing is signed by all the trustees.
- (s) To alter, modify and/or frame, schemes and rules and regulations for the carrying out of the Trust and for the Management and running of any institutions, school or establishments run by the Trustees and for managing the affairs of the trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects and purposes of the trust and to vary the same from time to time as the Trustees may in their alute discretion think fit and proper.

The Trustees responsible shall be chargeable only for such money, stock, stares finds as shall actually come into their hands and a trustee shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default acts or omission or commission of the other Trustees, nor of any banker or other person with whom the Trust properties or any securities may have been deposited or kept.

The Tustee may lodge for safe custody the shares, securities, investments and other properties forming part of the Trust Fund and the documents held by them relating to any property, of the Trust under these presents, with any Bank or Banks on such terms, as to payments of their charges for the same, as also for the withdrawals and deposits of securities and other matters as may from time to time be agreed upon between such bank and the Trustees.

- The Trustee may institute, conduct, defend, compound or abandon any legal procedure by or against the Trust or Trustee and allow time and indulgence for payment or satisfaction of any due for any claims or demands by or against the Trust.
- The Trustees shall not be entitled to receive any remuneration as Trustees but they may reimburse themselves of all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the trust or their duties relating thereof.

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- The receipt of a person authorised by the Trustees or a resolution of the Board of Trustees for any money paid or any property transferred or delivered to the Trustees in execution of any of the power hereof or for the purchase of property authorized to be sold shall effectually discharge any person or persons so paying, transferring or delivering.
- 12. The following will constitute the first Board of Trustees:-
 - (i) Sri Dayanath Sah
 - (ii) Sri Dilip Kumar Agarwal
 - (iii) Smt. Champa Rani Sah
 - (iv) Sri Sanjay Kumar Mandal
 - (v) Sri Akhilendra Kumar
 - (vi) Sri Rajeev Ranjan Arya
 - (vii) Sri Bishwesh Arya
- Sri Dayanath Sah, the settler cum trustee abovementioned will be Life Trustees and shall not be liable to retirement or removal under any of the provisions hereinafter contained.
- 14. (i) The power of appointing any trustee(s) of these presents shall be exercised by the majority of the Trustees.
 - (ii) The number of Trustees shall be not less than Three and nor more than Nine
 - (iii) It shall be lawful for majority of the trustees to appoint any person or persons as an additional trustee(s) though there may be no vacancy in the office of the Trustees.
- The Board of Trustees can remove any trustee in its duly called and meeting by a vote of majority of ¾ of the total number of trustees for the being of these presents.
- In case any trustees or trustee die or desire to retire or refuse to become or incapable or unfit to act, it shall be lawful for the continuing or surviving Trustees for the time being of these presents to appoint a Trustee or Trustees in the place of the Trustee or Trustees so dying retiring, refusing or unfit to act as aforesaid.
- A trustee may retire from office by giving two months notice to the other trustee of his intention so to do and such resignation shall take effect upon expiring of such notice or its earlier acceptance.
- 18. A Trustee shall be deemed to be incapable or unfit to become or to act as Trustee if
 - (i) He has been found to be of unsound mind by a court of competent jurisdiction and the finding is in force or
 - (ii) He is an undischarged insolvent and his appointment is ending or
 - He has been convicted by a Court of any offence involving moral turpitude and sentenced in respect thereof to imprisonment for not less than six months and a period of five years has not lapsed from the date of expiry of the sentence.
- That the Board of Trustees shall elect one of the first trustees to be the Chairman of the Trust for a term of Three years unless he reigns of his own. The Chairman shall preside over the meetings of the Board of Trustees.



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However when the Chairman shall not be able to preside over the meeting of the Board, the Board shall select one of themselves to be the Chairman of that meeting.

- 20. That the Board of Trustees may elect one of the first trustees to be the Managing Trustee of the Trust for a term of Three years unless he reigns of his own. The Managing Trustee shall look after day to day affairs including maintenance of records and accounts, arrangements of trustees meeting, issue of notices & circulars on behalf of the trust etc.
- 21. That the Board of Trustees may constitute separate committee/ managing committee/ governing body for Management of affairs and to have better control of any institutions, school or establishments managed by the Trust.
- 22. Unless otherwise decided by the Trustees the accounts of the trust shall be made up annually to 31st March each year and the same shall be audited by person qualified to act as an Auditor of a company.
- The Trust hereby created shall be irrevocable.
- 24. The Trustees may from time to time frame rules for conducts and regulations of the meetings of the trustees in the absence of such regulations:-
 - (a) The Trustees shall hold at least one meeting and may hold as many meetings as they think fit in every year. The quorum at a meeting of the trustee shall be of three.
 - (b) Any question submitted to the meeting snall be decided by a majority of the votes of the Trustees present at such meetings.
 - (c) The Trustees shall cause minutes of their proceeding to be entered in a book to be kept for that purpose.
 - (d) The Trustees may decide matters by circulation of the agenda of any meetings as may be convenient to them.
 - (e) A Trustee who is unable to be present at a meeting of the Trustees may send his view on the agenda in writing and such expression of opinion shall be taken to his vote on the matters concerned.
 - (f) Any resolution or direction or action passed given or taken in writing under signature of the majority of the Trustees shall have the same effect as a decision of the Trustees taken in a meeting except otherwise specifically provided by the provisions of this deed.
 - (g) In the case of an equality of votes in respect of any matter the Chairman of the meeting shall have a casting vote

I, the Author of the trust, do hereby declare that I have settled this trust and executed this trust deed with my own will and without any coercion, with sound mind and full senses. I have handed over the Trust Fund to the Trustees mentioned hereinabove for the purpose of the Trust.
